

Special Occasion Wine Selections

Meiomi, Pinot Noir • BTL 48

A rich garnet color, the wine reveals lifted fruit aromas of bright strawberry and jammy fruit, mocha, vanilla, and toasty oak. Expressive boysenberry, blackberry, dark cherry, juicy strawberry, and toasty mocha flavors lend complexity to the soft, plush palate. The well-integrated oak provides structure and depth seldom seen in Pinot Noir. ~ California

Banfi, Rosa Regale ~ Sparkling Red • BTL 52

Rosa Regale is a unique red sparkling wine. Soft and appealing, with a festive cranberry color. An aromatic bouquet with hints of raspberries, strawberries and rose petals. A light taste of fresh raspberries, with crisp acidity, enticing the palate with an initial softness, graduating to a clean and dry finish. ~ Italy

Roederer Estate, Sparkling White Brut • BTL 78

Roederer Estate Brut, the first California sparkling wine produced by Champagne Louis Roederer, builds upon a 200-year tradition of fine winemaking that has made Roederer champagne among the most sought-after in the world. Roederer's winemaking style is based on two elements: ownership of its own vineyards and the addition of oak-aged reserve wines to each year's blend or cuvee. All the grapes for the Anderson Valley wines are grown on the Estate.

Decoy, Rose 2020 • BTL 48

This aromatic rosé draws you in with tantalizing layers of white peach, honeydew melon and tropical lychee. On the palate, it shimmers with cool-climate verve and energy, offering mouth-filling flavors of grapefruit, Meyer lemon and orange blossom that culminate in a bright, beautifully focused finish. ~ Hopland, California

Decoy, Chardonnay 2020 • BTL 48

This beautiful Chardonnay offers luscious aromas of fresh lemon zest, Mandarin orange, honeysuckle, vanilla and caramel. On the palate, it is silky and rounded, with a creamy mouthfeel that adds depth and richness to the alluring citrus and tropical flavors. The finish is long and refreshing, with bright natural acidity carrying the wine to a vibrant fruit and spice finish. ~ California

Decoy, Cabernet Sauvignon 2019 • BTL 56

From its aromas of vibrant red and blue fruit to its silky tannins and balanced acidity, this is a lush and alluring Cabernet Sauvignon. On the palate, rich flavors of raspberry, ripe plum and blueberry carry the wine to a long, luxurious finish, with nuanced hints of oak and sweet baking spices. ~ California

Decoy, Sauvignon Blanc 2021 • BTL 48

This crisp and refreshing Sauvignon Blanc draws you in with tantalizing aromas of pineapple, Meyer lemon, green apple, lime zest, and flint. On the palate, lovely underlying acidity enlivens the zesty citrus flavors, culminating in a bright and energetic lemon-lime finish. 2021 ~ California

Goldeneye, Anderson Valley, Pinot Noir 2018 • BTL 90

A classic expression of Anderson Valley Pinot Noir, this wine begins with enticing aromas of bright cranberry, strawberry, blueberry, and blackberry, as well as savory hints of black tea, dried herbs, pennyroyal, and saddle leather. The lush fruit notes are echoed on the flavorful palate, where they mingle with layers of moist earth and wild mushrooms, with firm tannins and bright acidity carrying the wine to a poised and polished finish. ~ Mendocino, California

Featured Oregon Wines

Rose ~ Willakenzie • BTL 32

Floral and fruit driven, this refreshing Rosé wine has aromas and flavors of passionfruit, citrus and a stony finish. Acidity adds tension to the palate, which has firmness from neutral wood fermentation. ~ Oregon

Penner-Ash, Syrah • BTL 84

A decadent red wine composed of aromas of dark cocoa and dark berries with flavors of vanilla and dark fruit, accented by a slight smoky note. Sweetness and intensity at entry and a lengthy, lush finish.

This dry Riesling has aromas of sweet apricot, green apple and jasmine. A bright and focused palate is complimented by a balanced sweetness with flavors of orange blossom and candied lemon peel.

Freemark Abbey Wines

Freemark Abbey, Sauvignon Blanc 2020 • BTL 60

The Freemark Abbey Napa Valley Sauvignon Blanc white wine is a blend of several different vineyards from some of the most sought-after areas in Napa Valley. The Sauvignon Blanc grapes are harvested at their peak of ripeness and fermented in stainless steel and neutral French oak barrels to highlight the natural acidity and vibrancy while remaining classily balanced. This brilliant white wine is brimming with aromas and flavors of citrus, honeydew melon, peach and lemongrass. Refreshing acidity and a long, clean finish. ~ Oakville, California

Freemark Abbey, Merlot 2018 • BTL 90

The Freemark Abbey Napa Valley Merlot red wine represents the Napa Valley's natural ability to perfect Bordeaux varieties. The vineyards range from deep gravelly valley floor to high elevation mountainous volcanic soils. The depth of fruit coupled with the richness of flavor provides a profile that delivers from the initial sip. Aromas and flavors of cherries, wild strawberry and blueberry cobbler jump from this glass of this ruby-colored red wine. The spicy oak is well integrated with smooth flavors of baking spice, leather and plum. ~ Oakville, California

Freemark Abbey, Cabernet Sauvignon 2018 • BTL 105

A rich, opulent Napa Valley wine, this full-bodied dry wine is aged in oak barrels, resulting in a very well-integrated sweet oak spice, adding to the overall complexity. Sourced from select vineyards in Napa Valley, this Cabernet wine features balanced acidity levels due to moderately warm afternoons and early morning fog. A dark ruby red wine, with complex oak with flavors of dark berry fruit, cocoa, and Herbs de Provence. The body is full with supple tannins, a soft entry, and dark cherry flavors that develop from start to finish.

Freemark Abbey | Rutherford, Cabernet Sauvignon 2018 • BTL 180

The Rutherford Cabernet Sauvignon red wine program is a blend of fruit from Bosché and Sycamore Vineyards. The Rutherford 'Dust' is one of Napa Valley's most succinct terms, evoking in these four simple letters a specific place, a complex set of flavors, and a prestigious history dating back to 1838. This dark ruby red wine exhibits aromas and flavors of dark fruit, cedar, baking spices, cigar box and cocoa powder. The full body is balanced with good acidity and resolved tannins.
